Colour Coding



Product identification is made easy with the Agar Colour Coding system. We have 11 different categories of product

that are identified by colour and number. The product itself has this colour. Also, the colour and number are shown:

1. On the bottle label as supplied.
2. On the matching Dispenser Spray Bottle.
3. On the product chart for Colour Coded Cleaning.

This system has benefits of reducing the chance of using the wrong product, making compliance and staff training easy, showing that the correct products are being used and providing information about usage, dilution and first aid.

Application

Toilets:

- Pour 40 ml* of BOWL CLEAN into bowl under the rim. Scrub all surfaces with a nylon toilet brush. After 5-10 minutes contact time, flush the toilet. BOWL CLEAN kills household germs when used in the recommended quantity. Not for use on the toilet seat or lid.

Urinals:

- Apply neat* BOWL CLEAN to the surface and scrub all with nylon brush. Leave for a few minutes to activate, then flush.

* BOWL CLEAN can be used neat or diluted up to 1 part BOWL CLEAN to 2 parts water for regular cleaning.

Tiled floors and walls:

- Dilute BOWL CLEAN to 1 in 50.

DO NOT USE on marble, terrazzo or Laminex.

28mm Disc Top Cap Code: RIC - Allows bottle to be inverted so BOWL CLEAN can be applied under the rim of the bowl.
