Application:

VERSACLEAN is ideal for all high gloss porcelain & ceramic tile floors. Porcelain tiles are a very high quality variety of ceramic which is so dense it can be polished by special polishing stones to a very high finish. Glazed porcelain tiles are the most popular type of porcelain tiles and are made by using a decorative and super hard wearing glaze (which can be matt or gloss) over the porcelain base. Being a high gloss, these tiles will highlight soiling or poor cleaning technique, as these areas will show up as dull against the surrounding high gloss areas.

VERSACLEAN being a pH neutral requires no rinsing and as long as the cleaning solution is not over-contaminated from the cleaning process.

Since VERSACLEAN does not leave streaks, is low sudsing and requires no rinsing, it is suitable for use in automatic scrubbers.

VERSACLEAN can be used from 1:20 with water up to 1:100 with water as required by the application.
